## GMX Accepts Positive Independent Audit Report, Strongest Financial Position Since 2018

Miami, FL – The Greater Miami Expressway Agency (GMX) has accepted the favorable independent audit that projects fiscal stability for the agency.

MSL Certified Public Accountant’s unmodified opinion, covering the period from July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, affirms that the financial statements present a true and fair view of GMX, adhering to relevant laws and generally accepted accounting principles. Notably, the report highlights increased revenues, assets, and debt service coverage ratio for all bonds, while liabilities continue to trend downward.
