

Upcoming Joint Replacement Work at I-75 & Gratigny: Full Ramp Closures Scheduled for April

Miami, FL – The Greater Miami Expressway Agency (GMX), in partnership with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), will conduct joint replacement work at the I-75 and Gratigny Parkway (SR 924) interchange. This necessary infrastructure project will take place over two weekends in April and require full ramp closures to ensure safe and efficient completion.

Scheduled Ramp Closures:

- First Weekend: Friday, April 11th, at 9:00 p.m. – Monday, April 14th, at 5:30 a.m.
- Second Weekend: Friday, April 25th, at 9:00 p.m. – Monday, April 28th, at 5:30 a.m.
- Full Daytime & Nighttime Closures: All westbound lanes on SR 924/Gratigny Parkway to northbound I-75 will be completely closed during these periods.

Detour Route:

Drivers needing to access northbound I-75 from westbound Gratigny Parkway should follow this detour.



- Take the exit to W 4 Avenue/NW 57 Avenue
- Turn left on southbound W 4 Avenue/NW 57 Avenue
- Turn right at W 68 Street/NW 122 Street



- Turn left to access the northbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway on-ramp
- Continue northbound and take the exit to northbound I-75

GMX encourages drivers to plan ahead, expect delays, and seek alternate routes when possible. We appreciate the public's patience as we work to enhance roadway safety.
