Full Closure

All lanes on eastbound SR 112/Airport Expressway at NW 32nd Avenue will be closed for paving on **Friday, July 26 at 11 p.m. and will reopen on Monday, July 29 at 5 a.m.** Drivers should follow all posted detour signs. Detour information:

Drivers wishing to access I-95/I-195 can:

- Turn east onto NW 36th Street
- Turn left onto NW 27th Street
- Access the ramp to eastbound SR 112 on the right
- Continue to I-95/I-195

Or

- Turn south onto NW 42nd Avenue/LeJeune Road
- Access the ramp to eastbound SR 836 on the right
- Continue to I-95/I-195



Lane Closure

Up to two lanes on eastbound SR 112/Airport Expressway at NW 32nd Avenue will be closed for paving on **Friday, July 26 from 9 p.m. to 11 p.m.**
