Full Closure

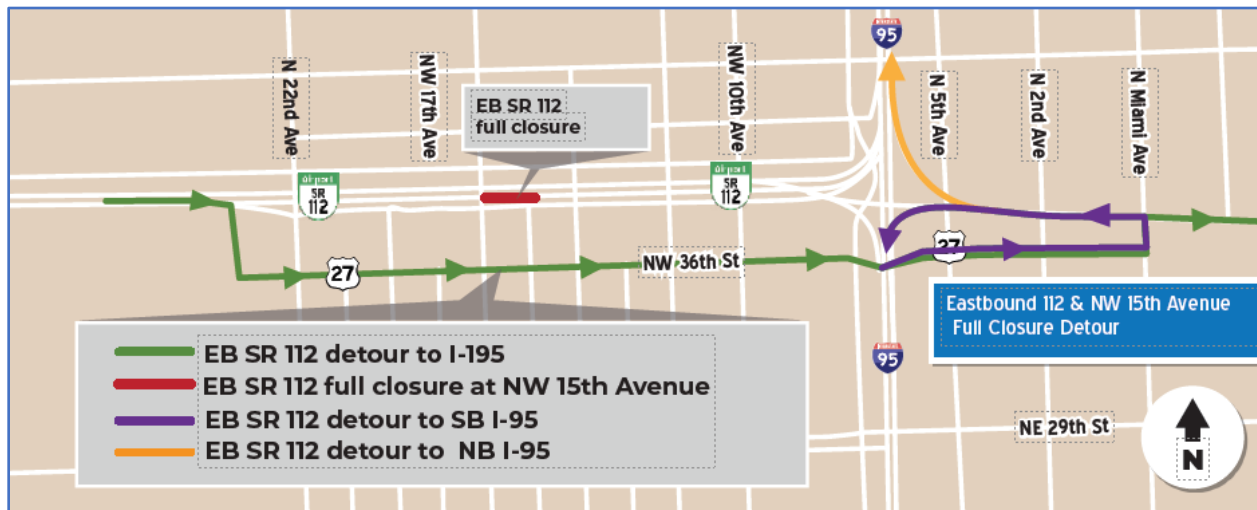
All lanes on eastbound SR 112/Airport Expressway at NW 17th Avenue will close for paving on **Friday, August 2 at 11 p.m. and reopen Monday, August 5 at 5 a.m.** Drivers should follow all posted detour signs. **Detour information:**

Drivers wishing to access I-195 can:

- Take exit for NW 22nd Avenue and turn right
- Turn left onto NW 36th Street
- Continue to I-195

Drivers wishing to access I-95 can:

- Take exit for NW 22nd Avenue and turn right
- Turn left onto NW 36th Street
- Turn left onto N. Miami Avenue
- Access ramp to northbound I-95 on right or southbound I-95 on left



Lane Closure

Up to two lanes on eastbound SR 112/Airport Expressway at NW 32nd Avenue will be closed for paving on **Friday, August 2 from 9 p.m. to 11 p.m.**



Lane Closure

A single lane on westbound SR 112/Airport Expressway from NW 22nd Avenue to NW 38th Avenue will be closed for road maintenance on **Tuesday, July 30 and Wednesday, July 31 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. each night.**
